EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR INCLUSION IN THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT TRIBUNAL SUPPLIER DATABASE

The Public Procurement Tribunal (the Tribunal) is a quasi-judicial body established under the Public Procurement Act. The Tribunal is mandated to adjudicate over public procurement disputes and grievances emanating from a procurement process.

The Tribunal is in the process of creating a supplier database that will be used to shortlist companies for procurement of goods, services and works. Therefore, the Tribunal wishes to invite prospective 100% citizen owned companies for the provision of the below listed supplies, services and/or works for inclusion in the database:

- Branding/Promotional Material
- Catering Services
- Cleaning Services
- ICT (Hardware, Software and/or Consultancy)
- Toners, Cartridges and related products.
- Car Rental Services.
- Photography and Makeup Services.
- Building Repairs & Maintenance (Minor works, electrical, plumbing, handy work).
- Office Furniture, Fixtures and Fittings.
- Office Stationery.
- Pest Control/Fumigation Services.
- Bottled water.
- Human Resource Consultancy (Recruitment, job profiling etc)
- Public Relations Consultancy
- Training Services

Eligible citizen owned companies should submit the following:

- Company Profile with physical address and contact details
- Valid Tax Clearance Certificate

- Relevant PPRA Codes*
- CIPA Registration Certificate (to be confirmed on the CIPA website)
- Certified identity documents of Directors and Shareholders

*Only applies to supplies/services/works above the micro procurement threshold of P100,000.00
